


THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

- I. Thou shalt have no other gods before Me.
- II. Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate Me: and showing mercy unto thousands of them that love Me and keep My commandments.
- III. Thou shalt not take the Name of the Lord thy God in vain; for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh His Name in vain.
- IV. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: but the seventh day is the Sabbath of the Lord thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: for in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it.
- V. Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.
- VI. Thou shalt not kill.
- VII. Thou shalt not commit adultery.
- VIII. Thou shalt not steal.
- IX. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.
- X. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor anything that is thy neighbour's



The Secret of Bible Study

Study IT through - Never begin a day without reading and understanding one of the questions of the next Sabbath's Lesson.

Pray about IT - Never leave your Bible until the text you have read and studied is a part of your very being.

Write IT down - The thoughts that God gives you put it on your margin or in a note book, etc. Refer to this when having the review or the study of the lesson in Sabbath school.

Work IT out - Live the truth you receive throughout the rest of the day and think about it as you go to sleep.

Pass IT on - Seek to tell somebody, your family, neighbour or friend, what you have learned and perhaps your listener will start to do the same thing as you. You will surely soon after have the beginnings of a Sabbath school.

- 19 And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and *from* the things which are written in this book. Deuteronomy 4:2; Revelation 1:3.

We are told repeatedly God's word is unchangeable why do so many add to and take away from it?

SABBATH STUDY MARCH 26, 2022

STATE OF THE DEAD

Scripture Reading: Job 14:10-14; 19:25, 26: Ecclesiastes 9:4-10. Golden Text: Job 14:12.

- 1. If you tell a person to not do something that they will be harmed and they do it did you cause it?
- 2. What did God warn Adam and Eve about, and what was the consequence of disobedience? Genesis 2:16, 17.
- 3. If one goes to heaven after death explain the account of Abel's blood crying out from the ground? Genesis 4:9-11.
- 4. What are we told of the state of the dead? Ecclesiastes 9:5, 6.
- 5. What testimony does Job give us as to the state of the dead? Job 19:25, 26.
- 6. What does John tell us, Jesus said about any one going to heaven? John 3:13.
- 7. What does Peter have to say about the state of the dead keep in mind that this is after Jesus' ascension into heaven? Acts 2:29.
- 8. What does Paul tell us will take place at the return of Jesus? 1 Thessalonians 4:14-17.
- 9. What do we learn about the dead in the following scriptures? John 11:2-14.
- 10. What is written in Ecclesiastes tell of the dead? Ecclesiastes 3:19-21; 9:4, 5, 10.
- 11. In completion of this study should we not foremost consider that God said we would surely die, and there should be no other consideration?

SABBATH STUDY MARCH 19, 2022

HOW LONG WAS JESUS IN THE GRAVE

Scripture reading: Matthew 12:30-42. Golden Text: Matthew 12:40.

- 1. The Christian churches tell us that Friday, Friday night, Saturday, Saturday night and Sunday is the crucifixion time of Jesus burial. What does Jesus say? Matthew 12:40.
- 2. Let us consider other comments from all other parties including Jesus. How would we interpret them?

Matthew 12:40; 26:61; 27:40; Mark 15:29, 30; John 2:19. Matthew 27:63; Mark 8:31; John 2:19, 20.

- 3. All these scriptures just read in question 2 are references back to what Jesus left as a sign in Matthew 12:40. So what is the corner stone scripture of all that has been read?
- 4. Did the Pharisees believe and understand what Jesus's sign was? Matthew 27:62-64.
- 5. What does John tell us about the Sabbath following Jesus' death? John 19:30, 31.
- 6. What day was the preparation for? John 19:14.
- 7. Mark tells us that the women bought spices to anoint the body after the Sabbath what does Luke tell us, and how can this be so? Mark 16:1; Luke 23:56.
- 8. Does this further prove there was two sabbaths in the crucifixion week? Luke 23:54-56.
- 9. Do we know when Jesus actually was resurrected, and left the tomb? Matthew 28:5, 7; John 20:1-9; Luke 24:9-16; Mark 16:6. In considering these scriptures remember Matthew 12:40 is the only sure time line.
- 10. After all we have read from God's Holy word can we believe that the world church's teachings of a Friday to Sunday crucifixion is true and accurate? What does Jesus teach a day consists of? John 11:9.

SABBATH STUDY JANUARY 1, 2022

- 6. What can we draw from Matthew 24:37-39?
- 7. Can we confirm what Jesus was speaking in Matthew 24:37? 2 Peter 3:6.
- 8. What does the Bible tell us lies ahead for the earth at judgment? 2 Peter 3:7.
- 9. What further are we told of this day of judgment? 2 Peter 3:10.
- 10. Does Paul support this teaching of Peter? 2 Thessalonians 1:7, 8.

SABBATH STUDY JANUARY 8, 2022

- 2. What further information are we given of this great day of the Lord? Revelation 6:13-17.
- 3. What other event are we told will take place at this time of the return of our Lord? Zechariah 14:2-5.
- 4. Are we able to bring this event forward to the New Testament? Revelation 16:14, 16.
- 5. After this last great conflict what does Zechariah tell us? Zechariah 14:8, 9.
- 6. Are we given any insight to the condition of the earth and mankind after these events? Isaiah 24:1, 3, 6.
- 7. What are we to take from the description given us of the beginning of Christ's reign? Isaiah 24:21.
- 8. Does the New Testament support this as well? Revelation 6:15-17.
- 9. When will Jesus return? Acts 3:20, 21.
- 10. What are we told of the state of the new earth notice the comparison of these two prophets? Isaiah 2:1-5; Micah 4:1-8.
- 11. What else does Isaiah tell us of this time under Jesus's rule? Isaiah 35:1, 2, 7, 10.

- 3. What does God declare about creation? Exodus 20:8-11.
- 4. How many days did God work? Genesis 2:1, 2.
- 5. Did God's people of old times follow God's example at creation? Exodus 23:12; Luke 13:14; Acts 13:42.
- 6. What can we understand from Genesis 2:4 dealing with creation?
- 7. What did God create on the sixth day? Genesis 1:31; 2:1.
- 8. Taking into account what we were told took place on the sixth day and what we are told in Genesis 2:4 how are we to interpret Genesis 2:5-7.
- 9. Keeping in mind what we are told in Genesis 2:4 first part what are we told God did with man at creation? Genesis 2:7-10.

- 5. There is no question until this point, we have studied the scattering and gathering of Israel fulfilled in our time. The question to consider is our we moving from verse 24 and on to real or prophetic time or both? Ezekiel 36:24-28.
- 6. What is God's promise to Israel? Ezekiel 36:29, 30.
- 7. What does God say Israel will be brought into remembrance of, and is it for Israel's sake? Ezekiel 36:31, 32.
- 8. Considering what we just read and also verses 33-35 can we apply this to events of today?
- 9. As to the last 3 verses what do we take from them as to the time line, the enquiring of Israel and what in particular do we take from verse 38?

SABBATH STUDY FEBRUARY 26, 2022

GOSPEL

Scripture Reading: 2 Corinthians 4:1-18. Golden Text: 2 Corinthians 4:4.

- 1. What was the gospel message that Jesus preached? Mark 1:14.
- 2. How far will this gospel reach? Matthew 24:14.
- 3. What does Jesus tell us about the Kingdom of God being at hand? Mark 1:15.
- 4. What does the gospel compare with by the preaching of Jesus? Mark 8:35.
- 5. What does Jesus emphasize has to be done? Mark 13:10.
- 6. Why do you think he has emphasized this? Mark 13:9.
- 7. What does Paul tell us is a part of the gospel message is? Acts 20:24.
- 8. What else does Paul tell us is now part of the gospel? Romans 1:9; 9:1.
- 9. As we read on, we learn that the gospel takes on more meaning. What does Paul now tell us of the gospel message? Romans 10:15.
- 10. Can we follow a false gospel? Galatians 1:6.
- 11. What is the penalty for preaching a false gospel? Galatians 1:8, 9.
- 12. What was the gospel message that Abraham received? Galatians 3:8.
- 13. Should we consider it a privilege to be trusted with the gospel and if so, how should we speak? 1 Thessalonians 2:4.

- 5. Does Jesus indicate that the commandments will continue to be taught and that there is a consequence for how they are taught? Matthew 5:19.
- 6. How do we know what commandments Jesus is speaking of? Matthew 5:21-28.
- 7. What is one of the criteria for entering the Kingdom of God? Revelation 12:17; 14:12.
- 8. Finally let us look at what Paul says about the law and how do we understand this message to us the last day Church? Romans 7:6-14.

SIGNS OF THE COMING MESSIAH

Scripture Reading: Isiah 53:1-12. Golden Text: Matthew 1:23.

- 1. What is the first prophecy about the coming messiah? Genesis 3:15
- 2. Is this prophecy fulfilled, and does it coincide with question one? Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:23.
- 3. How was Jeremiah 31:15 fulfilled? Matthew 2:16-18.
- 4. How specific is Hosea 11:1 prophecy to its fulfillment? Matthew 2:14, 15
- 5. The prophecy of Zechariah 9:9 was fulfilled in Matthew 21:4-10. What is the actual importance of the fulfillment of it?
- 6. Where do we find the fulfillment of the prophecy in Zechariah 11:12? Look in Matthew 26:15.
- 7. Once more looking to the specifics of this prophecy Psalm 41:9. How well is it fulfilled? John 13:18.
- 8. What was prophesied in Zechariah 11:13 that the money would be used for, and to what detail was it fulfill? Matthew 27:3-10.
- 9. The prophecy in Daniel 9:26; Isaiah 53:8 was fulfilled in Matthew 27:50; 2 Corinthians 5:21. For who does it say he died?
- 10. What are we prophetically told of Jesus death and burial? Matthew 27:57–60; Luke 23:33; Isaiah 53:9.

SABBATH STUDY FEBRUARY 12, 2022

- 4. At this time of great calamity what of the saints? Luke 21:36.
- 5. Prior to Jesus return what will be a great deception? Luke 21:8; Jeremiah 29:8; 2 Timothy 3:13; 4:3; Matthew 24:11; 2 Corinthians 11:13.
- 6. What will be the state of the world prior to Jesus' return? Luke 21:9, 10; Zechariah 14:13.
- 7. What other signs and events will take place? Luke 21:11, 12.
- 8. What takes place prior to the trumpet which is the wrath of the lamb? Revelation 7:1-3; Ezekiel 9:4.
- 9. What is next? Revelation 8:2-6.
- 10. When the voice of the seventh Angel begins to sound, what is declared? Revelation 10:7.
