

## THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

I. Thou shalt have no other gods before Me.

II. Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate Me: and showing mercy unto thousands of them that love Me and keep My commandments.

III. Thou shalt not take the Name of the Lord thy God in vain; for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh His Name in vain.

IV. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: but the seventh day is the Sabbath of the Lord thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: for in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it.

V. Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.

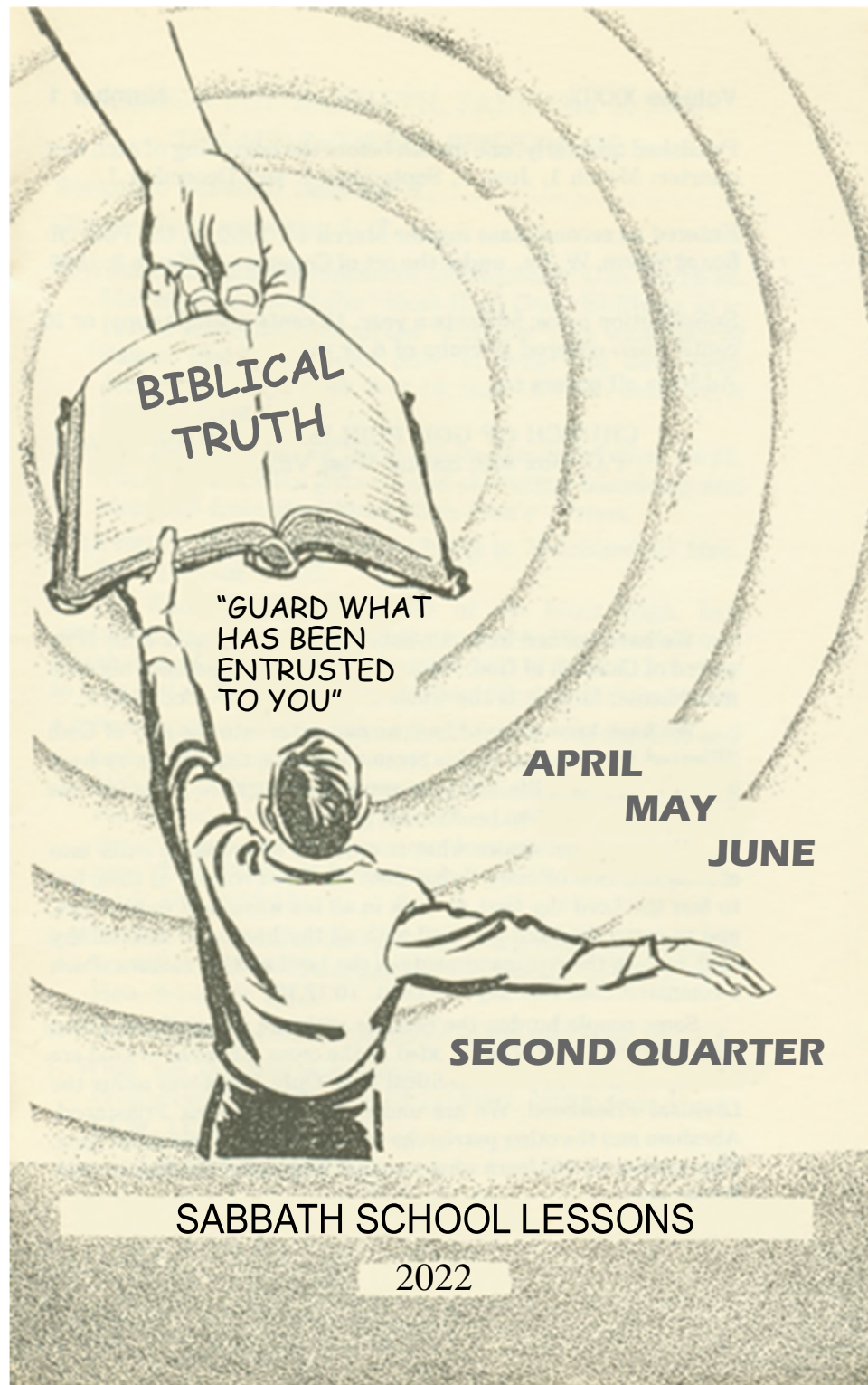
VI. Thou shalt not kill.

VII. Thou shalt not commit adultery.

VIII. Thou shalt not steal.

IX. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

X. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor anything that is thy neighbour's.



## **The Secret of Bible Study**

Study IT through - Never begin a day without reading and understanding one of the questions of the next Sabbath's Lesson.

Pray about IT - Never leave your Bible until the text you have read and studied is a part of your very being.

Pass IT on - Seek to tell somebody, your family, neighbour or friend, what you have learned and perhaps your listener will start to do the same thing as you. You will surely soon after have the beginnings of a Sabbath school.

## ***SABBATH, STUDY APRIL 16, 2022***

### **THE VAIL OF BONDAGE**

**Scripture Reading: Galatians 4.**

**Golden Text: Galatians 5:1.**

1. Why was the Levitical Priesthood instituted? Exodus 28:1-3; Numbers 16:9; Hebrews 5:4-6.
2. Why do we know that the Levitical Laws were added sometime later than the Ten Commandments were given to Israel? Deuteronomy 5:22.
3. The vail rending from top to bottom freed Children of God from the dreadful bondage of the Levitical Priesthood. Galatians 4:1-3, 9; 5:1; 2 Corinthians 3:14.
4. What specific things were made clear when this law was ended?
  - a. Receiving free access to God. Hebrews 10:19, 20.
  - b. The end of the Schoolmaster Galatians 3:22-25; 4:9, 10; Romans 10:4-8; Galatians 3:24, 25; Colossians 2:14; Ephesians 2:15, 16.
  - c. We become members of the Family of God. Ephesians 2:19, 20; Galatians 3:26-29; Hebrews 2:15-18.
5. There are many Christians that want to keep the Levitical and Melchizedek priesthood together. The first one is bondage and the last one is freedom. What is said about mixing them up among Children of God? Galatians 1:6-9. These two laws cannot co-exist. Read Galatians 4:19-31. They contrast each other.

## ***SABBATH STUDY, APRIL 23, 2022***

### **ORDINANCE OF THE LORD'S PASSOVER**

**Scripture Reading: Exodus 12:1-14.**

**Golden Text: Exodus 13:14.**

1. In what month was the first Passover observed? Exodus 12:1,2, 6; Leviticus 23:5; Numbers 28:16.
2. Is there a way to know when the first month starts? Numbers 9:3.
3. Is there a specific season? Deuteronomy 16:6.
4. What are the signs of this season and what season is it? Exodus 9:31, 32.
5. What is one reason that it is important that these harvests are ready (Abib)? Leviticus 23:6-11.
6. On what day of the first month of the year did the Children of Israel keep the Passover? Numbers 9:2-5; Joshua 5:10.
7. At what time of day does the day begin? Deuteronomy 16:6; Genesis 1:5; Matthew 28:1. The Bible day was from sunset one evening to sunset the next evening. Luke 24:29.
8. Should we follow men's traditions of astrology or star reading to set the Lord's Passover? Jeremiah 10:2; Matthew 15:3, 9; Mark 7:9.
9. Does God change? Numbers 23:19; Malachi 3:6; James 1:17.
10. Should God's Passover be set in accordance to how God set it, or by science and mathematics of man, and should it be kept whenever we want? Numbers 9:4, 5; 1 Corinthians 11:23-25.

5. Is an outward appearance all that is necessary to be holy? 1 Samuel 16:7; Matthew 23:25-28.
6. How did Paul apply this Biblical principle? Romans 2:17-25.
