



THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

V. Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.

VI. Thou shalt not kill.

VII. Thou shalt not commit adultery.

VIII. Thou shalt not steal.

IX. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

X. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor anything that is thy neighbour's.

The Secret of Bible Study

Study IT through - Never begin a day without reading and understanding one of the questions of the next Sabbath's Lesson.

Pray about IT - Never leave your Bible until the text you have read and studied is a part of your very being.

Write IT down - The thoughts that God gives you put it on your margin or in a note book, etc. Refer to this when having the review or the study of the lesson in Sabbath school.

Work IT out - Live the truth you receive throughout the rest of the day and think about it as you go to sleep.

Pass IT on - Seek to tell somebody, your family, neighbour or friend, what you have learned and perhaps your listener will start to do the same thing as you. You will surely soon after have the beginnings of a Sabbath school.

MYSTERY, a word which was borrowed from the heathen religion, in which mystery was a secret that separated one religion from another, and found outward expression in rites and ceremonies. The word, in the biblical sense, does not imply that the mystery is incomprehensible. In the Old Testament the meaning of the symbolism was not a secret of the priesthood, but it was the common possession of the people. In the New Testament, the word mystery denotes a secret hidden from the world until the appointed time (Romans 16:25), or until man is able to receive it. (Mark 4:11). Something known to God is unknowable to man until God chooses to reveal it. (Luke 8:10).

The Bible gives us to know the mysteries of the last days. The greatest of all of the mysteries revealed today is "Christ In You, the Hope of Glory." It is these mysteries we want to proclaim in this quarterly. It is warning every man and teaching every man in wisdom, that we may present every man complete in Christ Jesus. That is the end for which I toil in bringing them to you, striving with His energy, that His works may work mightily in me.

A mystery is a fact every mind can see, but no one can explain.

The Mysteries of the Bible are hid from those that do not have their names written in the Book of Life. If people belong to the Family of God the mysteries of the Word of God are revealed to them through the Spirit of God. Read Deuteronomy 29:29.
