V. Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.

VI. Thou shalt not kill.

VII. Thou shalt not commit adultery.

VIII. Thou shalt not steal.

IX. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

X. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor anything that is thy neighbour's.

COVETING ADDS TO SATAN'S GLORY (Giving in to Satan)

Scripture Reading: James 1.

Golden Text: James 1:20.

1. How do people glorify Satan? Hebrews 11:6; James 1:5-8. (Unbelief) It is a known fact that where people are taught the truth they have faith. Romans 10:17,18.
2. People glorify Satan through fear, and how is that brought on? Job 3:25, 26; 4:1-6. The devil's chief work is to deceive which then brings on fear.
3. People glorify Satan by giving in to him. James 1:13-15. Satan gets men to think that God has forsaken them. What does Peter say of this let down? 1 Peter 5:8-10; James 4:7.
4. People glorify Satan by permitting him to rob them of the promises of God. Psalms 1. Whatsoever a Child of God does shall prosper. Proverbs 3:6-10. How will the saints be rewarded? Malachi 3:10, 11; Matthew 6:33. If Children of God accept what God has promised and provided, then they can have the blessings. Luke 6:38; 2 Corinthians 9:6-10; 3 John 2.
5. How do people add to Satan's glory? Matthew 16:21-25. Peter is rebuked. Any dishonesty or false doctrine (any teaching contrary to revealed truth) should not be tolerated. Ephesians 5:3-6; Titus 3:1-6. If we covet anything then we certainly are helping Satan.
6. Have we been warned of false doctrines? Matthew 24:24-26; 15:9. All failure to fight for the truth and wage aggressive warfare against Satan is adding to his glory. You covet the ways of Satan. Matthew 25:40-46. Any twisting of Scriptures to prove a personal theory, in direct disregard to other Scriptures on the same subject is coveting your own self and your own ideas. 1 Corinthians 8:9. Name some of these false doctrines.

LESSON FOR SABBATH, APRIL 26, 2014

COVETING ADDS TO SATAN'S GLORY (Continued)

Scripture Reading: Habakkuk 2:1-14.

Golden Text: Exodus 20:17.

1. How did King Saul glorify Satan? 1 Samuel 28:8-14.
2. The covetous man's life is centred on self. How did Jesus parable of the covetous farmer show this? Luke 12:15-19. This man recognized neither God nor his fellowman. Ezekiel 33:31.
3. On what things were this rich farmer's mind set? Habakkuk 2:9; Luke 12:18 His life was centred on "goods," "fruit," and "buildings". They were the major objectives of his life.
4. Of what value is the life of the one always getting and never giving? Ecclesiastes 5:13; Malachi 3:8-10. "Eat, drink and be merry" is a fool's philosophy.
5. What other example of covetousness do we find when Israel entered the Promised Land? Joshua 7:1, 10-12, 20, 21. Ahab coveted the worldly goods of the people of Ai. Isaiah 56:10-12.
6. What husband and wife in the New Testament coveted the action of an Elder and were totally blinded by their greed? Acts 4:36, 37; 5:1-4
7. What dreadful thing happened to them because of their covetousness? Acts 5:5, 10, 11; Hebrews 13:5; Colossians 3:5.

4. What do we learn about God's name in the opening of this prayer? Matthew 6:9; Philippians 4:6, 7; Hebrews 13:15, 16.
5. What is the first thing we are taught to ask for? Matthew 6:10; Matthew 5:3; Matthew 25:34; James 2:5.
6. What is the first thing we are taught to seek to do? Matthew 6:10; Psalms 40:8; Matthew 12:50. Jesus our example prayed Matthew 26:39, 42. The rule of everyday life. James 4:15; Psalms 143:10.
7. After we have followed the above instructions, we have the proper relationship. Then we are ready to make our petition known to God. What is it? Matthew 6:11
8. What are we taught here about confession? Matthew 6:12; James 5:16; Mark 2:5; 1 John 1:9.

PROOFS THAT BODILY HEALING IS IN THE ATONEMENT OF CHRIST

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 38.

Golden Text: John 10:10.

1. Does forgiveness of sins and healing of the body go hand-in-hand? Isaiah 6:10; Matthew 9:1-8; James 5:14.
2. What is the healing power presented to us in Isaiah 53?
3. Do Isaiah and Peter say that by Jesus' stripes we are healed? Isaiah 53:5; 1 Peter 2:24. By this Jesus made atonement for all men.
4. Isaiah 53 literally means: "He was made sick," for us in providing the atonement. In the same sense: "He was made sin for us," 2 Corinthians 5:21; 1 Corinthians 11:29. Sin and sickness are two curses plaguing mankind. Exodus 15:23; Exodus 23:24, 25.
5. Is God able to preserve the condition of men, and is it by His word? Psalms 105:37; 107:20.
6. What else was a type of Christ's atonement? Numbers 21:5-9; John 3:14,15; 2 Corinthians 5:20.
7. Every time an Israelite was healed, atonement had to be made. Leviticus 14:14-18. How is atonement made today? Ephesians 5:25-27; 1 John 1:9; Romans 5:11; 12:1, 2.

1. Is it true that God makes man sick and brings on death in order for Him to be glorified? John 9:1-3; John 11:4; Psalms 34:19. The reason God healed was to prove that He did not want men to be ill. Hebrews 12:5-11; 3 John 2; Psalms 20:1
2. Why does mankind choose to believe this lie? 2 Corinthians 4:4; Acts 26:16-18 ; 1 Peter 5:8.
3. Why are we chastened by the Lord? 1 Corinthians 11:32; Hebrews 12:10; Hebrews 12:5, 6.
4. What causes man to not move out in faith? Matthew 13:58; 17:20; Hebrews 3:9
5. What is the outcome for the unbelieving? John 3:18; Jude 5; John 8:24.
