MARY'S WISE CHOICE

Scripture Reading: 1 Corinthians 1.

Golden Text: Luke 10:42.

1. What is the lesson learned between Mary and Martha. Luke 10:39. Martha is a picture of the natural person. Matthew 6:33; Luke 9:59, 60.

2. In what way are the saints enjoined to the Lord by fear Deuteronomy 10:12, 13; Joshua 24:14; Isaiah 8:13.
3. When you truly and honestly fear God what will you begin to receive? Proverbs 1:7; 9:10; Job 28:28.
4. When you fear the Lord thy God what are you promised? Psalms 25:14; 97:10; Proverbs 19:23.
5. If we eschew evil, (1 Peter 3:11) what will be our reward? Genesis 15:1; Psalms 19:9-11; Psalms 58:11; Isaiah 62:11. "Eschew" means to depart, shun, avoid.
6. Will everyone who learns God's truth fear Him? Romans 1:28-32.

NOTE: These Scriptures show us that in order to fear God you must depart from evil. Departing from evil is keeping the Commandments of God and the testimonies of Jesus Christ. Those that do this are saints. The Bible tells us that we must fear God. We must depart from all evil.

RELIGION IN THE HOME

Scripture Reading: Genesis 28.

Golden Text: Joshua 24:14, 15.

1. What did Job show us about concern for others? Job 1:4, 5.
2. In what way did Jesus respect the children of the people of Israel? Matthew 19:13-15.
3. How did Jesus bring the gospel message to a home in the Gadarenes? Luke 8:38, 39.
4. What did Jesus say to Martha concerning Mary in their home? Luke 10:38-42.
5. Whole families have been recorded as Believers of Christ and the Gospel. John 4:49-53; Acts 16:15, 33, 34.
6. Where is one of the best places to teach the gospel and Jesus Christ? 1 Timothy 5:4;

Mark 5:19; Acts 12:12.

7. How does the Psalmist express himself and the home that belongs to the Lord? Psalms 128:3-6; 127:3-5; 113:9.

LESSON FOR SABBATH, NOVEMBER 29, 2014

THE RESULTS OF WRONG TEACHING IN THE HOME

Scripture Reading: 1 Samuel 2:27-36.

Golden Text: Colossians 3:20.

NOTE: The priesthood was taken from the family of Eli because he failed to control his children.

1. What caused the removal of the house of Eli? 1 Samuel 2:23-25. Eli used lip service only in controlling his sons. This kind of reproof is not sufficient. .

2. Is it enough to just tell our children to be good? 1 Samuel 3:12-14. Parents must restrain their children as well as reprove them. In this way they will have proper control over them.

3. Is it dishonouring God for parents to honour their children more than God? 1 Samuel 2:29; Proverbs 29:15.

4. What happened because of the disobedience of Samuel's sons? 1 Samuel 8:1-5. Samuel was a judge in Israel. He did not learn from the experience of Eli and his sons. The disobedience of Samuel's sons caused the judge-ship to be taken away from the family.

5. What happened to Sennacherib because of his uncontrollable sons? 2 Kings 19:37.

6. What does an unrestrained son do to his parents? Proverbs 17:25; 29:15.

7. In the house of the wicked who is the main instigator of wickedness? Micah 7:5, 6; 2 Timothy 3:2.

8. Ungrateful children begin in a small way to ridicule their parents. If allowed to continue they will become terrors in the home. What do we read in Deuteronomy 21:18-21. Naturally we cannot stone our rebellious children therefore we must ask them to leave the home. The son leaving home is like one dying in trespasses and sin. Luke 15:24; Ephesians 2:1-5.

9. The results of wrong teachings in the home are: Hatred, Genesis 27:41; Envy, Genesis 37:11, 19-20; Ungrateful Children, 2 Samuel 15:4,5; Avarice, Proverbs 15:27; Slothfulness, Ecclesiastes 10:18.

LESSON FOR SABBATH, DECEMBER 6, 2014

PERSONAL BEHAVIOR

Scripture Reading: Titus 3.

Golden Text: Ephesians 4:31.

Proper SPEECH is important to the GROWING Child of God.

1. What is required of the Child of God concerning his speech? James 3:6, 9, 10; James 4:11; Ephesians 4:25, 29.
2. Is it possible to temper our mouth if we try to follow after truth? James 3:13, 2.

2. Paul's reason for joy in the fellowship? Philippians 4:4; Acts 2:4; Philippians 1:3-5; 1 John 1:3, 4.
3. What is Paul's reason for rejoicing in the love of Christ? Romans 8:35-39; Psalms 91:14-16; John 17:26; Titus 3:4-6.

4. What is Paul's reason for rejoicing in and under all conditions? Philippians 4:10-12; Philippians 4:7, 9, 11; John 14:27; Ephesians 2:14; Colossians 1:20; 2:10.
5. What is Paul's reason for rejoicing in the power of Christ? Philippians 4:10, 13; John 15:5; John 10:27-30; 17:11, 12.
6. What does Paul give the overcome to look forward to? 2 Timothy 4:7, 8. There is an incentive to fight if the victory is assured. 1 John 5:4; John 16:33; James 1:12; 1 Peter 3:4.
7. What does Paul tell us we should do? 1 Corinthians 11:1.
8. Why does Paul have the right to say this to us today? Romans 11:13.

SCRIPTURAL WORDS OF WARNING

Scripture Reading: Acts 20:1-25.

Golden Text: Isaiah 58:1.

1. Warning concerning building. Matthew 7:24-27. Men on earth are particular about foundation to buildings. 1 Corinthians 3:11; Matthew 16:18; Acts 4:10-12.
2. Warning concerning ignoring danger. Matthew 23:37-39. We should learn from the mistakes of others in the past. Matthew 23:34; 1 Corinthians 10:6-11; Proverbs 4:14, 15.
3. Warning concerning going into bondage. Galatians 5:1. With the Galatians it was the Mosaic Law. It may be other things also for other people. But many are still in bondage to feast days and holy days. Ephesians 4:22-24; Colossians 2:6-10; Matthew 11:28-30.
4. Warnings concerning numerous temptations. Luke 21:34-36. Temptation comes when you least expect it and from many different sources. Luke 14:18-20; 1 Corinthians 10:12, 13.
5. Warning concerning the danger of neglect. Hebrews 2:3. Sins of omission as well as sins of commission. 1 Timothy 4:14; 2 Peter 3:1, 2.
6. Warning concerning our labour for the Lord. Galatians 6:7, 8. The law of sowing and reaping. By our sowing we bring about conditions. Matthew 13:19-23; Romans 5:12; 2 Corinthians 9:6.
7. Warning concerning watchfulness. Matthew 24:36-44. Watch these: words, actions, thoughts, conduct, heart and mind. Mark 13:37; 1 John 3:1-3.
8. Warning concerning the necessity to make proper decisions. Deuteronomy 30:15. The Lord lets us be our own free agent. Joshua 24:15; Ruth 1:15, 16; 1 Kings 18:21.
