


#### THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

- I. Thou shalt have no other gods before Me.
- II. Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate Me: and showing mercy unto thousands of them that love Me and keep My commandments.
- III. Thou shalt not take the Name of the Lord thy God in vain; for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh His Name in vain.
- IV. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: but the seventh day is the Sabbath of the Lord thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: for in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it.
- V. Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.
- VI. Thou shalt not kill.
- VII. Thou shalt not commit adultery.
- VIII. Thou shalt not steal.
- IX. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.
- X. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor anything that is thy neighbour's.



## The Secret of Bible Study

Study IT through - Never begin a day without reading and understanding one of the questions of the next Sabbath's Lesson.

Pray about IT - Never leave your Bible until the text you have read and studied is a part of your very being.

Write IT down - The thoughts that God gives you put it on your margin or in a note book, etc. Refer to this when having the review or the study of the lesson in Sabbath school.

Work IT out - Live the truth you receive throughout the rest of the day and think about it as you go to sleep.

Pass IT on - Seek to tell somebody, your family, neighbour or friend, what you have learned and perhaps your listener will start to do the same thing as you. You will surely soon after have the beginnings of a Sabbath school.

- 19 And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and *from* the things which are written in this book. Deuteronomy 4:2; Revelation 1:3.

# JUDGMENT OF THE WICKED SET OUT BY THE OLD TESTAMENT

Scripture Reading: Psalms 10:1-18 Golden Text: Psalms 9:5

- 1. What are some of the events that take place at the return of Jesus and setting up of God's Kingdom? Isaiah 66:16, 20; Psalms 58:11; Ezekiel 39:9-10
- 2. What happens to the wicked? Ezekiel 39:11-16
- 3. How are we to interpret Zachariah 14:12? Then read verses 13-18.
- 4. What will the righteous do in the Isaiah 66:24
- 5. Staying with Isaiah verse 24. What are we told about the bodies?
- 6. Are these alive in eternal punishment or are they dead? Once again verse 24
- 7. What are we told about the grave? Ecclesiastes 9:4, 5, 10
- 8. Why do the wicked continue to do evil? Ecclesiastes 8:11
- 9. What are we told about the wicked and his place? Psalms 37:10
- 10. What are we told not to fear and of the wicked? Proverbs 3:25

## LESSON FOR SABBATH, JANUARY 7, 2017

### WHEN WAS THE BIRTH OF JESUS

Scripture Reading: Luke 1:23-44 Golden Text: Matthew 1:23

- 1. To first understand the time lines we must establish when God's year starts. Exodus 12:1, 2
- 2. How do we know when this month is? Exodus 9:31, 32
- 3. Now that we know that God's year starts in the spring, when the grains are just starting to grow wheat etc. We will start to track the birth of Jesus. When was Zachariah in the Temple fulfilling his duties? Luke 1:5, 8
- 4. How do we know when this course or duty took place? 1 Chronicles 24:10, 18
- 5. We now know that each watch was two weeks long, and Zachariah's watch was the 8th following after his ancestor Abijah from scripture. Counting forward 8 watches from the middle of March when would Zachariah be in the Temple?
- 6. We now have the approximate time of Elisabeth's conception why is this important? Luke 1:21-26, 30, 31, 34-36
- 7. In verse 36 of Luke 1 the word "also" tells us what?
- 8. When we counted forward the 8 watches we would have come out about Middle of July to early August this was the time of Elisabeth's conception. The question now is when was Elisabeth's sixth month up?
- 9. We have now counted forward 6 months coming to early January and we have been told that Mary visits Elisabeth at this time and has just conceived herself. We can now know the approximate time of Jesus birth by counting forward 9 months from January. When was Jesus born?

## LESSON FOR SABBATH, JANUARY 14, 2017

### **CLEAN AND UNCLEAN FOODS**

Scripture Reading: Leviticus 11:1-47 Golden Text: Genesis 1:29

- 1. When is the first dietary law given? Genesis 1:29
- 2. What was that law? Genesis 1:29
- 3. To keep it simple what is the criteria for the beast we can eat? Leviticus 11:3
- 4. What of the creatures of the sea? Leviticus 11:9
- 5. What of the fowl and insects? Leviticus 11:13-20; 21-23
- 6. Was there a knowledge of clean and unclean before these laws were given? Genesis 7:1-3
- 7. Many who want to pervert God's word bring us to 1 Timothy 4:3,4 and say see everything is good. What does 1 Timothy 4:5 say it must be sanctified by? So, what is Paul telling us?
- 8. What is another controversial example we have? Acts 10:9-15?
- 9. What can we conclude is in the sheet? Acts 10:12
- 10. In verse 13 Peter is told to kill and eat from that which is in the sheet. What is Peters answer? Acts 10:14
- 11. What is God's answer to Peter? Does he speak to that which is unclean? Acts 10:15
- 12. We know that the thrust of this is that all mankind is clean, we cannot ignore the fact that God uses unclean and common beast to deliver this message never speaking directly of clean animals. Why didn't he just tell Peter to go to this gentile's home?

- 2. How should we interpret Ephesians 1:11-13
- 3. Do we know that God's Holy Spirit was with men of the Old Testament? Psalms 51:11; Isaiah 63:10, 11; Exodus 31:3
- 4. Whose spirit descends upon Jesus? Matthew 3:16
- 5. Let's compare some scripture: 1 Corinthians 12:3 with 1 John 4:2, 3. Many speak the name of Jesus from these scriptures, how do we know who speaks by the spirit?
- 6. We have read that the Holy Spirit was with men of the Old Testament what are we told in the New Testament? John 7:39
- 7. Can we see any difference between the Old Testament Spirit and the Spirit of the New Testament? 1 Corinthians 6:11; Titus 3:5, 6
- 8. Can we conclude that through the justification of Jesus the Christ we have this new Spirit? Acts 10:39-45

## LESSON FOR SABBATH, FEBRUARY 18, 2017

### SUPPORTING THE CHURCH

- 1. Why did Abraham give a tithe to Melchisedec? Hebrews 7:1, 2.
- 2. How are Jesus and Melchisedec compared? Hebrews 5:6.
- 3. When Jesus was chastising the scribes and Pharisees what did he say about tithing? Matthew 23:23.
- 4. What does the apostle Paul write Timothy about supporting the elders? 1 Timothy 5:17, 18.
- 5. Do we have a High Priest that we should honour as Melchisedec was? Hebrews 7:15; 7:2; 5:5, 6.
- 6. Are we to give by the law or by faith? 2 Corinthians 9:6-8.
- 7. We are told by the churches that works are dead what does James say? James 2:18.
- 8. Although the tithe is the acceptable amount to give are we judged by what we give if we're honest about what we give? Acts 5:1-10.
- 9. In the Old testament Israel is promised blessings for tithing and giving are we promised likewise? Luke 6:38; 12:30-33.
- 10. Will Jesus bless us for being faithful in all things? John 21:6-11; Luke 5:1 -10.
