Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: but the seventh day is the Sabbath of the Lord thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: for in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it.

V. Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.

VI. Thou shalt not kill.

VII. Thou shalt not commit adultery.

VIII. Thou shalt not steal.

IX. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

X. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor anything that is thy neighbour's.

HOW LONG WAS JESUS IN THE GRAVE

Scripture Reading: Matthew 12:30-42

Golden Text: Matthew 12:40

7. Mark tells us that the women bought spices to anoint the body after the Sabbath what does Luke tell us, and how can this be so? Mark 16:1; Luke 23:56.

8. Does this further prove there was two Sabbaths in the crucifixion week? Luke 23:54-56.
